

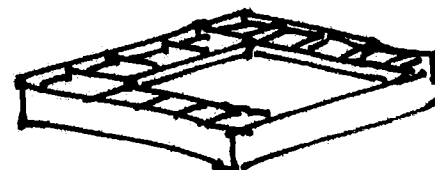
Basic Supplies-



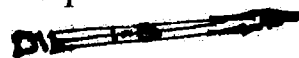
Paint.... Transparent watercolor tubes.....*No Hard cakes!!*
I like 'Winsor Newton' best, however if you are just starting, Cottman will do and is less expensive.....

Colors: Ultra Marine, Cerulean Blue, Cobalt Blue, Prussian Blue, Olive Green, Hookers Green [dark], Winsor Violet. New Gamgoge, Lemon Yellow [or Cad. Lemon], Naples Yellow, Burnt Sienna, Cadium Red, Cadium Red Light, Rose Madder, Raw Sienna, Raw Umber, Burnt Umber, Sepia, Payne's Grey, *All are transparent colors.....Permanent White [gouche]

Palette: Large covered palette similar to 'Pike Palette



Brushes: Flats.... $\frac{1}{2}$ ".....1".....1-1/2" Rounds: no. 4, 6, 8, 12, and no. 2 or 4 rigger.....these can all be synthetic..less expensive... Real 'Sable are nice , but need to sell your car to buy them!



Water Container....Pencils: No 2 soft [I like Dixon Ticonderoga] available at Office Max] Also 1 B ex. soft.....**Kneaded eraser,.. Masking Tape-3/4"**,....
Paper; Winsor-Newton or Arches 140 lb. Cold Press..[No blocks] ...Board to hold paper while painting..can be 1'4" ply or similar..approx. 18" X 24"
Something to carry supplies in.....bag, box etc....



Optional equipment: sm pocket knife or single edge razor blade, $\frac{1}{2}$ credit card, spring clips, 2 each, paper towels, small make-up natural sponge, liquid frisket,.. small spray bottle,.. sm. Sketch tablet.....
