

Drawing Class Supply List

Graphite pencils: 2B, 4B, and 6B (I like mechanical pencils because they stay sharp, but they usually only come in 2B variety. You'll have to buy the 4B and 6B pencils in the open stock section of your art supply store. Bring a pencil sharpener for them if you have one)

A 14" x 17" (or other, but no smaller than 11" x 14") sketchpad (white 60 lb. - 90lb. paper)

Kneaded eraser

White plastic eraser (i.e. "Magic Rub")

1 permanent ink (i.e. Sharpie) fine or ultrafine point black marker

1 waterbase ink fine point black ink marker (i.e. Crayola brand type) OR a fine point "dry erase" marker.

1 waterbase ink fine point marker in any other dark color

1 4B OR 6B graphite stick (available in drawing tools section of area art supply stores)

1 6B black charcoal pencil (This is a soft charcoal)

1 white charcoal (or pastel) pencil

Masking or drafting tape or "removeable" Scotch brand tape

18" metal ruler

Smooth surface Drawing Board – big enough for your sketchbook size paper

Small box of facial tissues

Several small paper blending stumps (tortillions)

8"x 10" Plexiglas (1/8", 3/16" or 1/4" thickness)

1 pre-cut mat – 8"x10" with an opening cut to 6" x 8"

Optional, but bring if you have:

A small spotlight or high intensity lamp

A small free standing mirror
