### DESCRIPTION:

Entries may be submitted into the following categories: Water Based Media, Oil Based Media, Dry Media, Mixed Media & 3-Dimensional Media. Please view the back of this prospectus for category descriptions and Juror information. All 2-D hanging work must be framed with screw eyes and wire (no saw tooth hangers). Work must be under glass or Plexiglas if on paper. Maximum size: 38" X 38" FRAMED. No work may exceed the weight of 100 pounds and it must be able to fit through a standard door. Each category will have a First-Place Prize of \$125, a Second-Place Prize of \$50, a Third-Place Prize of \$25 and up to three Honorable Mentions.

### ELIGIBILITY:

The Cuyahoga Valley Art Center's (CVAC) 34th Annual Juried Exhibition is a national exhibition, meaning this is it open to all artist within the United States.

### ENTRY FEE:

Members of CVAC: \$30 for up to two (2) entries  
Non-Members of CVAC: \$35 for up to two (2) entries

### RULES:

All works shall be labeled with the artist's name, address, email address, phone number, title and cost. If an image is not for sale please label it as such. After all entries have been received, a juried selection shall take place, dictating which images will hang in the show. If an entry is not selected, the artist will be contacted on **Monday, OCT 9<sup>th</sup>** to pick-up their artwork. CVAC reserves the right to determine the acceptability of any

work. Items not conforming to this prospectus will be automatically rejected. The jurors have the final say as to what category a submitted artwork belong within.

### SHIPPING:

Shipments should be made in REUSABLE cartons. All entries will be returned in the same cartons in which they were received. Entries must meet post office and UPS regulations and unless otherwise specified, cartons will be returned UPS. CVAC recommends the use of Plexiglass for shipping. Please include a completed entry form, a check payable to CVAC to cover entry fees and a pre-paid shipping label for return shipping. Shipped entries will be returned in a timely fashion after the exhibition.

### LIABILITY:

Artists must provide their own shipping insurance. Entries will be handled with all possible care, but the CVAC will not be responsible for loss or damage to submitted artwork from any cause whatsoever. Submission of artwork to this exhibition implies acceptance by the artist of all conditions set forth in this prospectus. CVAC is not responsible for abandoned artwork.

### SALES:

A commission of 30% will be charged on all sales. Payments will be distributed to artists after the conclusion of the exhibition in a timely fashion. Purchases by private and corporate collectors will be strongly encouraged.

### PUBLICITY:

The Cuyahoga Valley Art Center reserves the right to photograph participating artists and exhibited works for marketing purposes.

- WATER BASED MEDIA:** This category will include any media that is water-based such as watercolor paints, acrylic paints, tempera paints, etc.
- OIL BASED MEDIA:** This category will include any media that uses oil as its binder such as oil paints, oil pastels, oil based markers, etc.
- DRY MEDIA:** This category will include media that is dry such as graphite, charcoal, pastels, colored pencils, Conté crayon, silver point, etc. and media that uses a fluid solvent or carrier such as marker, pen or ink.
- MIXED MEDIA:** This category will include any work that combines traditionally distinct visual art medias such as work that might include both paint, ink and collage. Note: If watercolor pencils are used and then water is applied, it is considered to then be mixed media.
- 3-DIMENSIONAL MEDIA:** This category will include any work that occupies space through the dimensions of height, width and depth.

He recently won 1st place at the 2015 Kaleidoscope Holiday show, top five runner-ups for the Akron Art Prize five years in a row and Best of Show at the 29th Annual Regional Juried Art Show at the Cuyahoga Valley Art Center. Tom also received the best sculpture award at the 70th Annual Ohio Exhibition at the Zanesville Museum of Art. Tom is one of the new artist studios on the 3rd floor at the Summit ArtSpace Building. Tom served 5 terms as a Councilman-at-large for the City of Wadsworth 2000 – 2008. Tom is currently a trustee and Treasurer for the Cuyahoga Valley Art Center and teaches bird carving classes there. Tom is also Secretary for the City of Cuyahoga Falls Board of Zoning Appeals. He lives in Cuyahoga Falls with his wife, Barbara, and their two dogs.
