ESSENTIALS NEEDED FOR FIRST DAY:

- Sketchbook and Pencil

COLORS:

For This Class, You Can Start with Just 3 Acrylic Colors Plus Black and White:

- Phthalo Blue
- Magenta
- Hansa Yellow
- Mars Black
- White Gesso

Additional Suggested Colors:

- Lemon-Yellow or Cadmium-Yellow Light
- Cadmium Orange
- Cadmium Red Medium
- Alizarin Crimson
- Diazonium Purple
- Cerulean Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Permanent Green

PAINTING SURFACES:

Acrylic can be applied to; Canvas, Canvas Board, Watercolor Paper, Mixed Media Sketch Book, Card Stock coated with Gesso, etc.

BRUSHES:

- 1" Flat Long Handled Synthetic Brushes
- ½" Flat Long Handled Synthetic Brushes
- #7 or # 8 Round Brushes (synthetic is best for acrylic painting)
- 1" or 2" Paint Brush (old and beat up brushes are fine)
- Fan Brush (optional)

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:

- Acrylic Medium - gloss or matte
- Plastic to Cover 4-foot Table (*shower curtain, cheap plastic tablecloth etc.*)
- Squirt Bottle (*for water misting*)
- Paper Towels
- Palette to Mix Paint On (*can be paper plate, plastic coffee can lid, piece of plastic or glass*)
- Mixed Media Sketchbook (*for painting in*)

For the first day of class, students only need to bring a mixed media sketchbook & pencil to take notes in. We will be going over all of the supplies needed for the class at that time.
