Gelli printing is a form of art called monoprinting. Previously in order to do it you had to have a press to transfer the paints from the plate to the paper or fabric. Today there is a new method called a gelli plate, which allows you create beautiful monotypes without a press. The first day of this workshop will cover the steps and process for making multiple Gelli Plate papers. The second day will be focusing on assembling papers into fabulous mixed media works of art.

Student will be required to bring their own supplies. Class Size Limited.

Supply List:

- Gelli Plate: 8x10 or Larger OR Multiple Smaller Sized
- 4" Brayer (larger is fine)
- Acrylic Paints: Black and Any Other Colors of Your Choice
- Acrylic Paint Brush: 1" (or larger)
- Paper: ANY TYPE WILL DO (*typing paper, craft paper, just something with some tooth*)
- Matte Medium & Liquid Elmer's Glue
- Scissors & X-actor Knife
- Markers, Pencil's & Metal Ruler
- Stencils & Rubber Stamps of Your Choice
- Newspaper (we will have some as well), or Foam Book: For Cleaning the Brayers
- Paper Towels
- Plastic: To Cover Your Table With (plastic tablecloth, trash bag cut open, etc)
