This is a beginning-advanced level workshop. Bring what you have, and purchase what you can easily afford. The list below is the bare minimum of what you will need for the workshop.

#### **PALETTE OPTIONS:**

- Glass (recommended), wood, or disposable palette pad
  - Glass: recommended with a sheet of neutral grey paper underneath. With a glass palette, you will need to pick up a razor blade paint scraper.

#### **PAINTING SURFACE OPTIONS:**

- Arches oil paper (best option), Watercolor Paper (primed with several layers of gesso), Canvas Boards, canvas pad sheets
  - Anything 12x 16 or larger will be ideal

#### **PAINTS:**

Bring whatever oil paints you already have, you can use any brand you prefer. No lead white paint please. Below is a list of suggested paints but again, feel free to bring whatever oil paints you already have:

- → Small tubes (37 mL or similar)
  - Titanium White
  - Ivory Black
  - o Cadmium Red Light
  - o Cadmium Yellow
  - o Ultramarine Blue
  - Acrylic gesso

### **ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:**

- Disposable Gloves
- Gamblin or Dorland's cold wax (pint)
- Plastic to cover your table while working
- Coated Freezer Wrap Paper
- Brayer (cold wax academy has best) or Speedball soft rubber brayer
- Squeegees: silicone dough and bowl scraper (Messermeister is best)
- Odorless mineral spirits
- Citra Solve (non toxic cleaning agent) (optional)
- 1 roll of paper towels/or multiple rags

- Palette knives Metal or Plastic
- Several old oil painting brushes The brushes will become 'wax' brushes after one use
- Wax paper
- Tissue paper
- Baby oil
- Tape
- OPTIONAL: Stencils (if you have them)
- OPTIONAL: Oil sticks (if you have them) not to be confused with oil pastels
- OPTIONAL: Any texture-making tool
