This is a beginning-advanced level workshop. Bring what you have, and purchase what you can easily afford. The list below is the bare minimum of what you will need for the workshop.

**PALETTE OPTIONS:**

- Acrylic - Styrofoam plates and freezer paper
- Watercolor\* – Watercolor palette

**PAINTING SURFACE OPTIONS:**

---

- Watercolor paper, illustration board (cut to 8"x8" or 10"x10"), canvas panels, cradled panels, students can use leftover mat pieces, too. Basically, students can work with any size paper, canvas, or board stock, but for ease of getting started with our "play", the smaller sizes are easiest to manage.
  - Any surface that will stand up to paint and collage.

**PAINTS:**

Bring whatever acrylic & watercolor\* paints you already have, you can use any brand you prefer.
