- Adapt instruction to accommodate students' varying ages, abilities, and learning styles, offering both individual and small-group guidance.
- **Demonstrate proper techniques** using a variety of art materials, tools, and equipment while ensuring a safe classroom environment.
- **Encourage self-expression and artistic confidence** by fostering an engaging and supportive atmosphere for young artists.
- Maintain classroom organization, ensuring proper care, storage, and distribution of materials to prevent waste or damage.
- Communicate with parents/guardians regarding student progress, class schedules, and exhibition details.
- Prepare and submit supply lists to CVAC Staff as needed.
- Set up and clean studio spaces before and after class, ensuring a well-maintained learning environment.
- Support CVAC's programs and initiatives by performing additional duties as needed.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS & SKILLS

- **Teaching Experience:** Previous experience teaching art to children in a school, community-based, or arts education setting.
- Artistic Expertise: Strong proficiency in various artistic techniques and materials suited for K-12 students.
- **Classroom Management:** Ability to create a structured yet flexible learning environment that fosters creativity and engagement.
- **Effective Communication:** Strong ability to convey artistic concepts in an engaging and age-appropriate manner while maintaining open communication with students, parents, and CVAC staff.
- **Physical Requirements:** Must be able to lift 10–15 lbs, set up classroom spaces, and maintain a clean work environment.
